PLASTIC BAGS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN OR CART

HERE'S WHAT NOT TO RECYCLE



- ▶ Any grocery, retail or trash plastic bag
- ▶ Bread bags
- ▶ Dry cleaning bags
- ▶ Fruit and vegetable bags (fresh/frozen)
- ▶ Garden product bags (soil/mulch)
- ▶ Newspaper bags
- ▶ Outer wrap from paper towel, napkin and diaper packages
- ▶ Outer wrap from cases of soda, juice and snacks
- ▶ Zipper or stand-up pouches, bubble or cling wrap
- ▶ Crinkle bags for cereal, pasta or snack bags
- ▶ Outer wrap from meat or cheese products

Esto es lo que no se debe reciclar

- Cualquier bolsa de plástico para comestibles, minoristas o basura
- Bolsas de pan
- Bolsas de limpieza en seco
- Bolsas de frutas y verduras (frescas / congeladas)
- Bolsas de productos de jardinería (tierra / mantillo)
- Bolsas de periódicos
- Envoltura exterior de paquetes de toallas de papel, servilletas y pañales
- Envoltura exterior de cajas de refrescos, jugos y bocadillos
- Puches con cremallera o stand-up, burbujas o envoltura adhesiva
- Bolsas arrugadas para bolsas de cereales, pasta o snacks
- Envoltura exterior de productos cárnicos o de queso

Leaf season is officially upon us! Cottage City's leaf program will run until January 15, 2021. Please remember, you can **continue to put your leaves in PAPER bags for regular yard waste pickup**. The Town of Cottage City will notify residents of upcoming snow and ice weather events via the Township web page, Cable Channel, Facebook and the Constant Contact email system as soon as snow and ice operations are expected to begin. Whenever possible, additional notifications may be issued before and during the operations.

I also want to take time to say that for the most part when my department approached you with a code compliance issue you brought violation under compliance, THANK YOU. Please keep up the good work. The winter months have its own set of issues. While grass and weeds are in hibernation we must deal with fallen leaves, clogged drains, and gutters. We request that you disposed of your leaves in approved Leaf recycling bags.

Plastic bags containing yard waste will not be accepted. Recycling must be placed in the marked recycling containers. If you have an abundance of household recycling **please do not use plastic bags**. You may use an extra container designated for recycling at your cost. Bates trucking is also requesting that residents place only 4 ITEMS OF BULK TRASH OUT AT A TIME. MATRESSES MUST BE PLACED IN MATRESS BAGS TO PREVENT POSSIBLE BED BUG INFESTATION. Please note that the items must be placed at the curb on Tuesday, and Bulk Trash removal is Wednesday.

Tips:

- Have your packages delivered elsewhere, such as your place of employment, an Amazon delivery site, P.O. box, or FedEx/UPS location. It's well worth the minor inconvenience to ensure your packages are safe.
- Request that deliveries require a signature.
- Subscribe to delivery alerts.
- Keep the area around your front porch clear and visible.
- Request nondescript packaging. When possible, ask senders not to announce where package is coming from, especially if it is a high-end store.

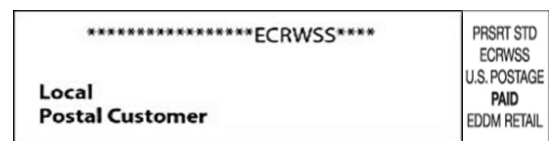
