A RESOLUTION OF THE COTTAGE CITY COMMISSION authorizing staff to apply for the Maryland Energy Administration Maryland Smart Energy Communities Grant Program for FY 20 for the acquisition of an Electric Vehicle and Energy Saving Windows for the Town Hall pursuant to the appropriation of funds to purchase said items.

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WHEREAS, the Town Charter, Section 18(28) grants the Commission the power to pass ordinances not contrary to the laws and Constitution of this State, for the specific purpose to accept gifts and grants of federal or of State funds from the federal or State governments or any agency thereof, and to expend the funds for any lawful purpose, agreeably to the conditions under which the gifts or grants were made; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2019, the Cottage City Commission enacted Emergency Ordinance 2019-02 adopting the annual budget and tax levy for FY 2020; and

WHEREAS, in addition to said emergency budget ordinance, the Cottage City Commission further adopted the Detailed Budget for FY 2020 and designated Line Item # 4130 (Maryland Energy Administration Grant) appropriating \$85,000 as municipal revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cottage City believes itself to be qualified, and is willing and able to carry out all the activities described in the state grant application; and

WHEREAS, in this action, the Town has declared its intent to conduct the project described in the application; and

WHEREAS, in this action, the Town will, upon an award and acceptance of the grant, agree to the terms of the grant.
