TOWN OF COTTAGE CITY RESOLUTION – 2020-05

A RESOLUTION concerning COVID-19 Hazard Pay for Essential Personnel of the Town of Cottage City.

WHEREAS, the global pandemic Coronavirus ("COVID-19") continues to pose an imminent risk to the health, safety and welfare of Cottage City residents and employees; and

WHEREAS, emergency declarations issued at the federal, State and County level remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to present economic and personnel challenges for the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has recommended that the Town pay a \$2 per hour hazard pay differential for essential personnel on the front lines of dealing with citizens, vendors, and other members of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cottage City Commission of the Town of Cottage City, Maryland, that the following listed essential personnel shall receive a \$2 per hour hazard pay differential.

AND BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, as we continue to address the COVID-19 pandemic, essential employees covered by COVID -19 Hazard Pay are the following:

- a) Police Officers, and
- b) Full-time Public Works Staff.

AND BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the COVID-19 Hazard Pay will start with the pay period beginning March 30, 2020, and continue until the County declaration of emergency is terminated.

AND BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect on the day it is adopted and shall be retroactively applied commencing March 30, 2020.
